About the Program

The Black Belt Certificate program is designed for experienced practitioners with a Green Belt Certificate (or equivalent process improvement experience) who wish to achieve a higher level of Lean Six Sigma training by developing critical skills for leadership in enterprise-wide deployment.

In this instructor-led course, participants spend 90 hours in the classroom and 30 hours in the field applying the Lean Six Sigma methodologies. Students become grounded in the established Lean Six Sigma body of knowledge, facilitate a Black Belt project, and earn the credentials to be a Lean Six Sigma leader within their organization. This course is limited to 12 participants.
